**KITE SETUP**



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## Step 1: Unpacking the kite

**Unpack your kite and place it down with the bottom skin facing upwards on an open beach where there are no sharp obstacles.**





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## Step 2: Sanding the tip

**Fold over a small part of the upwind tip and place some sand on it.**

***Hint: The less you fold over, the more the kite can inflate in the tip area, this is important for a smooth launch with no collapsing.***





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## Step 3: Pre-inflation

**Open the zipper.**  
**With a smooth steady wind the zipper can hold it's own shape, and inflate automatically whilst unwinding your lines.**



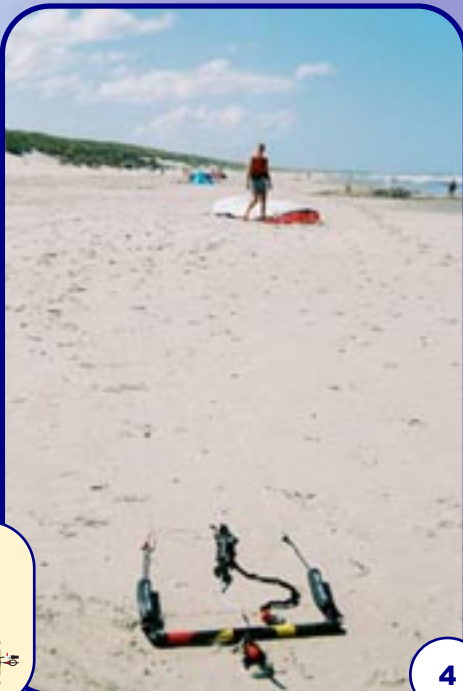


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## Step 4: Getting your bar and lines ready

Place your bar and lines on the ground 30 meters upwind of your kite. Make sure the lines are free of tangles.



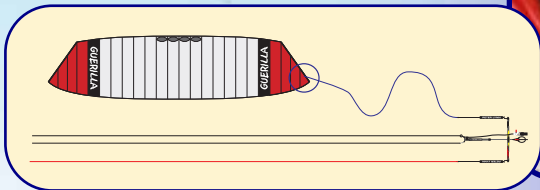


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## Step 5: Attaching lines

Attach the brake line to the upwind tip using a larkshead knot.



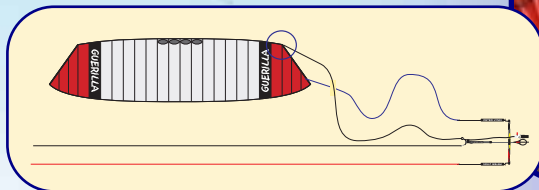


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## Step 6: Attaching lines

**Attach the top line onto the Leading Edge attachment point by crossing over the brake line, and attaching.**



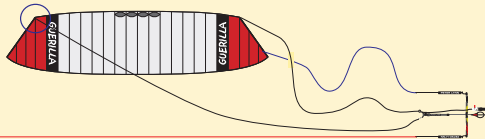


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## Step 7: Attaching lines

**Attach the top line to the down wind tip, directly on to the Leading Edge attachment point.**



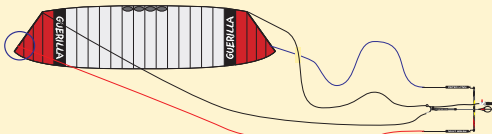


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## Step 8: Attaching lines

**Attach the brake line to the down wind tip, directly to Trailing Edge attachment point.**





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## Step 9: Closing the zipper

**Close the zipper once kite has completed inflation.**

***Hint: To get a better inflation, close the zipper, and squash the centre of the kite, so the air can travel to the tip. The more inflation in the tip, the safer the launch.***





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## Step 10: Making sure the lines are clear

Make sure that the lines on the upwind tip are clear to prevent the line from catching the rod.





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## Step 11: Getting ready to launch

**At the down wind tip, have the lines crossing over the kite so when tension is applied the tip can catch the wind, and take off.**

***Hint: You can get a helper to hold the tip off the ground until you get tension on your lines.***

**Stand so your lines are 45 degrees to the wind direction.**



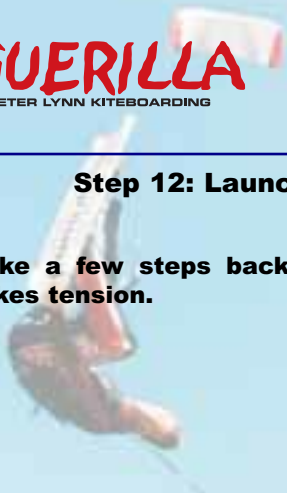


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## Step 12: Launching

Take a few steps back so the line takes tension.





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## Step 13: Launching

Take a few more steps back. Let the kite slowly come up.





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## Step 14: Launching

The kite takes its shape while sliding backwards...





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## Step 15: Launching

...and slowly takes off.





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## Step 16: Letting the kite fully inflate

Let the Guerilla complete its inflation to 100% (this will happen in the first 10 seconds) and slowly bring the kite up to the zenith.
